INSTRUCTIONS

WHO MAY FILE. An exemption application may be filed by a beginning farmer or a beginning livestock producer who has been certified by the Beginning Farmer Board.

A certificate from the Beginning Farmer Board stating that the applicant meets the criteria necessary to claim an exemption of taxable agricultural and horticultural machinery and equipment must be attached to this application.

WHEN AND WHERE TO FILE. This application for exemption must be filed with your county assessor

on or before December 31 of the year preceding the year for which the exemption is to begin.

Missing the filing date or failure to provide the required documentation will result in denial of the exemption for the following year.

WHAT PROPERTY IS EXEMPT. Any beginning farmer or beginning livestock producer who qualifies may have exempted from personal property tax for three years no more than one hundred thousand dollars of taxable value of agricultural or horticultural machinery and equipment for each year.
